Happy New Year!

Attendance has been very positive so far, and we want this to continue into next week. To support good attendance, we have adopted the <u>RKLT Attendance policy</u> this year. It also contains important details about reporting absence and the support available, if needed. We know that post-Covid all schools, across the country, have seen absence rates increase. You may have noticed that your son/daughter has brought home a new piece of essential equipment – the Student Planner. This has key information in it, such as their timetable, and will be used to record home learning. Please take some time to look at it with your child and asking them, when they pack their bag, 'Have you got your planner?' would be really helpful. We would also ask that all parents and carers sign our 'Home-School-Student Agreement' on p14.

As I mentioned in my letter last term, we are now using Class Charts to recognise and reward students and have introduced an additional positive point this year. At the start of each lesson, if a student is showing they are ready, by being on time, correctly equipped and dressed, they will receive an automatic positive point. This week alone our students have collected 10,000 positive points. We look forward to seeing how many they get next week. Students have been given log in details allowing them to see the points they have been awarded by staff, so they can show you this weekend how they have done. You will soon be sent details on how to view your own child's profile. As part of this change, we have updated our <u>Respectful Relationships and Behaviour</u> Policy. This is a key policy that we would ask all parents and carers to be familiar with and fully support.
