Wednesday 16th October was a busy day at Rossett, with vitally important Restart a Heart lessons going on throughout the school. This made us think about just how many job roles make a positive impact on heart health. You can explore some of the less well known job roles that could help to restart a heart using the links below.

<u>Cardiac Physiologist</u> - using high-tech equipment to assess patients with heart problems.

<u>Occupational Therapist</u> - working with patients following a life-altering heart attack to maximise their level of independence in day-to-day activities.

<u>Dietitian</u> - looking at how healthy diet and lifestyle choices can be introduced following a heart attack or used to prevent cardiac problems.

<u>Healthcare Science Assistant</u> - supporting medical staff, with duties ranging from lab testing blood samples to monitoring patients' heart function.

<u>Health Promotion Specialist</u> - educating and informing people about health issues.


<u>Performance Sports Scientist</u> - using knowledge of how the body works to help people improve their health e.g. to prevent or treat heart disease.

<u>Clinical/Biomedical Engineer</u> - designing, developing and maintaining medical equipment used to diagnose illness and treat patients.

<u>Charity Fundraiser</u> - organising events and activities to encourage people to donate to causes and organisations.

Health Play Specialist - using therapeutic play activities to help children and young people cope with illness, treatment and recovery.

<u>Pharmacologist</u> - studying the effects of drugs and chemicals on living things, and developing new products to help tackle disease.

<u>Emergency Medical Dispatcher</u> - taking details from 999 call handlers, and deciding the best emergency response to send to the scene.

# CAREERS AROUND SCHOOL




Wednesday 16th October was also World Food Day, an awareness day organised by the United Nations to raise awareness about hunger around the world. This year's theme was 'foods for a better life and a better future'.

During careers meetings, we often look at the <u>UN's</u> <u>17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)</u> when we talk about the student's values. Some students feel so passionately about social good that they want to explore how they can align their career with their values, whilst others want to work in an unconnected role, but plan to contribute financially to the causes that matter most to them.

For those students who would like to work for an institution that contributes to one of the 17 SDGs, there are many opportunities in fields as varied as education, international development, and nature conservation.

Interested students might like to start by looking at courses and job roles using search terms like 'environment and sustainability', 'international development', 'food and consumer science or nutrition', 'agriculture and related sciences', 'conservation', and 'ecology'.

Students might also like to think about volunteering when they are old enough - for a conservation charity or one that organises food banks, homeless projects, community kitchens or meals on wheels.
